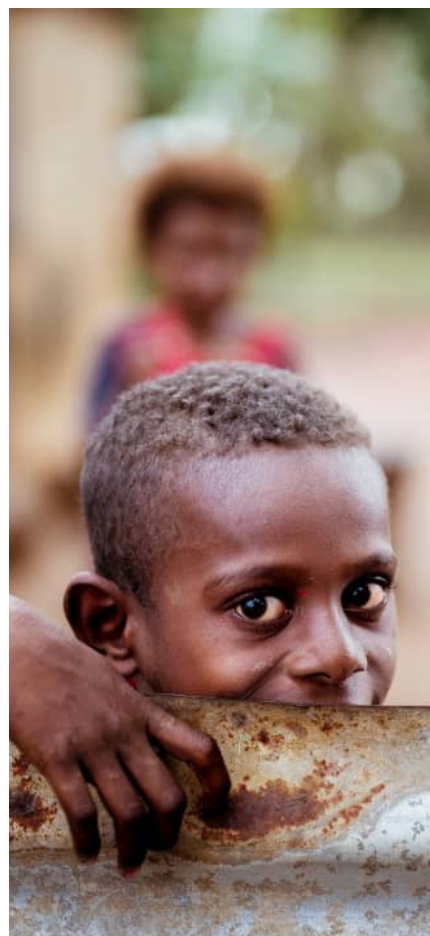

Right to leisure, recreation and cultural activities *Every child is entitled to respect for the dignity of his person, and accordingly, no child shall be-*

(1) Every child is entitled to rest and leisure and to engage in play, sports and recreational activities appropriate to his age. *(a) Subjected to physical, mental or emotional injury, abuse, neglect or maltreatment, including sexual abuse;*

(2) Every child is entitled to participate fully in the cultural and artistic activities of the Nigerian, African and world communities. *(b) subjected to torture, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment;*

(3) Every Government, person, institution service, agency, organization and board, responsible for the care and welfare of a child shall, at all times, ensure adequate opportunities for the child in the enjoyment of the rights provided for the child. *(c) subjected to attacks upon his honor or reputation.*

(d) Held in slavery or servitude, while in the care of a parent, legal guardian or school authority or any other person or authority having the care of the child.

STRENGTHENING HOPES WITH LOVE

RIGHT TO PARENTAL CARE, PROTECTION AND MAINTENANCE

(1) Every child has a right to parental care and protection, and accordingly, no child shall be separated from his parents against the wish of the child except-

(a) For the purpose of his education and welfare; or

(b) In the exercise of a judicial determination in accordance with the provisions of this Act, in the best interest of the child.

(2) Every child has the right to maintenance by his parents or guardians in accordance with the extent of their means, and the child has the right, in appropriate circumstances, to enforce this right in the Family Court.

Right of a child to free, compulsory and universal primary education, to,

(1) Every child has the right to free, compulsory and universal basic education and it shall be the duty of the Government in Nigeria to provide such education.

(2) Every parent or guardian shall ensure that his child or ward attends and completes his

(a) Primary school education; and (b) Junior secondary education. (C) Senior Secondary School Education

- (4) A female child who becomes pregnant, before completing her education shall be given the opportunity, after delivery, to continue with her education, on the basis of her individual ability.
 - (5) Where a parent, guardian or person who has care and custody of a child, fails in the duty imposed on him under subsection(2) of this section, commits an offence and is liable-
 - (a) On first conviction to be reprimanded and ordered to undertake community service;
 - (b) On second conviction on a fine of two thousand naira or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to both such fine and imprisonment; and
 - (c) On any subsequent conviction on a fine not exceeding five thousand naira or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
 - (6) The provisions of this section shall not apply to children with mental disabilities.
- In keeping with these constitutional dates TempleChild foundation is determined to protect the rights of the average Nigerian child who could not enjoy governmental and societal covering.

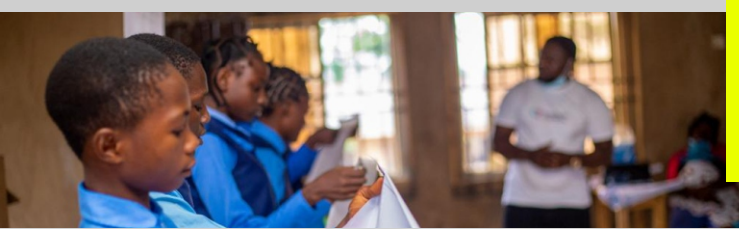

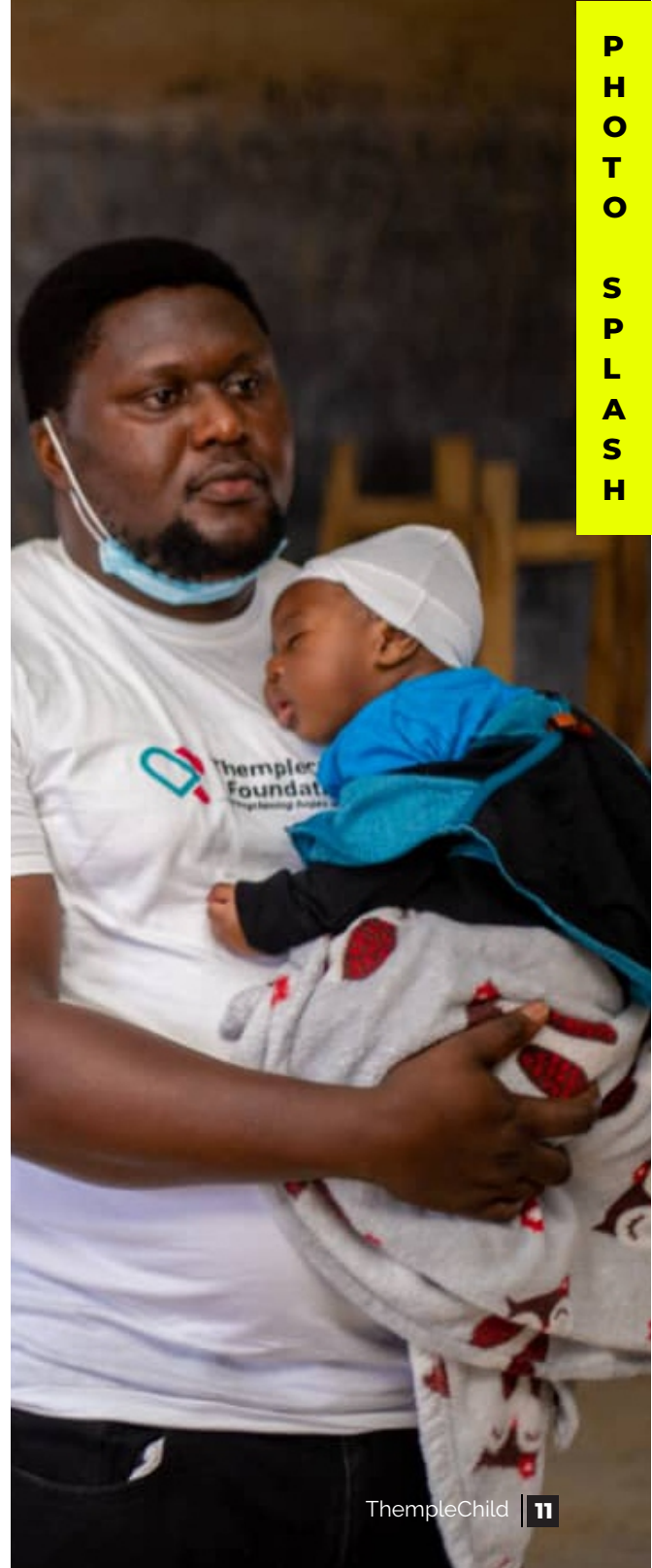
